



MESSAGE FROM THE CHIEF RABBAN





FROM THE GARAGE OF THE ROYAL CHARIOTS

“HAPPY BIRTHDAY” - The Royal Chariots are 35 years old this year. The Royal Chariots were chartered on February 4th 1984 by Illustrious Potentate Ted Grinager.

Frank Beck, one of the charter members, envisioned the Divan needing transportation in the Parades. In ancient times Royalty in their purple robes were transported in chariots. In that sense we are carrying on the tradition in Shrinedom with our Royal Chariots. There were 8 charter members, Dave Bagby, Pat Bagby, Frank Beck, Harry Ferris, Gordon Harris, Louie Knight, Andy Sorsabal and Bert Duncan. Harry Ferris is our last surviving charter member.

The purpose of the Royal Chariots is to assist the Potentate and officers of El Bekal Temple in the entertainment for ceremonial sessions and on such occasions at the discretion of the Potentate as will further the interest of El Bekal Temple.

I have been a member of the Chariots for almost 20 years. I became a member after one of the Huntington Beach 4th of July Parades. At the time I was a member of the Ali Babas marching unit- you know, the unit that has the uniform of leather shoes with turned up toes with bells, simetar with shirt and vest. Now it was about 98 degrees but it seemed like 110 and the Parade went for about 2 miles that seemed like 10 miles up hill. I was marching with Bert Ekstrom and I think Don Leger but anyway, when we got to the end of the Parade I could barely walk. We were hot tired and needed a drink. I walked up to these guys in the dune buggies and they were laughing and giggling and drinking cold drinks that they all carried in their buggies. And my feet said “hey, maybe we need to start riding not walking”. So I became a Royal Chariot and my feet are still thanking me.

Now I don't know what the Divan did before the Royal Chariots but I do know the service we have provided for the past 35 years has been invaluable. I think about how many pairs of shoes the Divan has saved and how many cows we have saved by saving all of that shoe leather. By saving cows we have increased the farmers herds and by increasing the farmers herds we have saved a renewable resource. That makes the Royal Chariots one of the greenest units in El Bekal.

For the past 35 years we have saved the Past Potentates and all the elected Divan members from an incalculable number of blisters and how much has Johnson and Johnson lost in Band=Aid sales? but I digress. Our Birthday celebration will be an ongoing theme throughout the year.

I know all the units are looking for new members so all of you new members who don't belong to any unit, we want you to take a good look at the Royal Chariots. We try to have fun at every event we participate in. Our Ladies are always included in everything we do and sometimes they have more fun than we do.

The most important thing is to get involved in a unit or club. Whatever your interest there are always others that share those same interests.



News from Cincinnati

2019 Burn Awareness Week

National Burn Awareness Week takes place February 3-9.

The focus of this year's campaign is preventing burns from scalds. According to recent statistics, the overall number of major burn injuries are down however the proportion of those burns caused by scalds has steadily increased. They are the cause of over one-third of all burn related injuries.

Eighty five percent of scald injuries occur in the home. With children under the age of five, that number increases to 95 percent. Many of these burns occur from spilling or pulling down hot liquids from stoves or tabletops.

One common example is coffee— it takes less than two seconds of exposure to water at 148° to cause injuries serious enough to require surgery, yet most coffee is heated to 175°.

Another frequent area for scalds in children is the bathroom. Hot water heaters should be set at 120°F, or just below the medium setting.

HOUSEHOLD TIPS TO AVOID CHILDHOOD INJURIES DUE TO SCALDS:

- Make sure children have a safe, supervised play area out of the traffic path between the stove and the sink.
- Use placemats instead of tablecloths around small children, who may use the cloths to pull themselves up.
- Never hold hot liquids when holding a child, and never set them i reach of young children.
- Turn pot handles toward the back of a stove, and keep cords for electric hot pots and cookers out of reach.
- Always test bath water with your hand or elbow before immersing a child, and keep the temperature at 100°.
- If a burn does occur, remove clothing from the injured area, stop the burn process with cool (**NOT** cold) water, then cover the area with a clean, dry sheet or bandage and seek medical attention.

As always, we count on your help to spread the word about burn safety, and to make sure families know where their children can receive the finest specialty care.

HOT TIP #1

Babies and older adults have thinner skin so they're at risk for deep burns at lower temperatures and short exposure times.



HOT TIP #2

Never carry hot liquids while holding or carrying a child. Get a lid for your coffee or tea to prevent scald burns.



HOT TIP #3

If you have to leave the bathroom while bathing a child, take them with you.



HOT TIP #5

Never place hot liquids on low coffee tables or end tables that a young child can reach.



HOT TIP #4

Did you know? 62% of people treated in burn centers for scald burns are children under the age of 5.
